#### **Individualized Attention**

Unique to the Blue Mountain experience is the extensive amount of individualized coaching and teaching each student receives. Students spend 4 to 6 hours per day in private and small group instruction with our world-class faculty, who are dedicated to both teaching and performing.

#### **Preparation & Performance**

Our schedule is rigorously focused toward preparing musicians to give excellent performances with their chamber groups at the festival's close. We take time to develop individualized schedules, thus providing maximum challenge, support and opportunity for each student. The faculty and student performances constitute one of the most important and creative aspects of the program. All recitals are free and open to the general public.

#### **Location & Housing**

The camp takes place at Franklin and Marshall College, Lancaster, PA. Students reside in college dormitories.

#### **Eligibility**

Applications are being accepted for outstanding high-school, collegiate and pre-professional musicians for the next season of Blue Mountain Festival. Younger students are eligible to apply if recommended by their teacher.

### Audition Requirements

We require two contrasting works that represent the applicant's highest level of technical and musical ability in voice, violin, viola, cello, piano or flute. Submission may accompany the application or be sent under separate cover and can be formatted as a CD, DVD, URL link (e.g. YouTube), or digital file (send to [bluemountainfestival@gmail.com](mailto:bluemountainfestival@gmail.com)). A submission is required from all applicants (new and returning) and is necessary for balancing the chamber ensembles.

### Application Procedure

Complete the application form. Enclose the \$50 registration fee made payable to Blue Mountain Festival. Enclose a CD or DVD containing the audition requirements for your instrument. Clearly label the disc with your name, age, instrument, composer, and title of the pieces. Send the form, check and placement disc to:

### Deadline

All applications should be received by March 31. Late applications will be reviewed at the discretion of the executive director.

### Acceptance

All applicants will be notified by letter regarding their acceptance into the program. If accepted, a deposit of 50% is due immediately to reserve a space. The remaining balance is due by June 1. A \$75 discount is given if payment is made in full by March 31.
